Money Skills for Teens

An interactive 3-week workshop designed specifically to help teens develop strong money management skills.

Build a solid foundation for teens and help them prepare for long-term financial success and a brighter future!

It is imperative for teens to develop strong money management skills early in life to set them up for a successful financial future. UCLA Extension's goal for this course is to teach students how and why money is used while providing a roadmap for starting a solid financial plan.

Topics include:

- How to identify and prioritize money management goals
- Developing a budget that can help maximize your money
- Investment primer and how your money can work for you
- Understanding credit and the cost/risk of using credit, including college loans
- How to protect assets once they begin to accumulate.

The interactive workshop also provides segments on career building and the key life skills needed for the next generation of workers. Students are encouraged to bring their laptops to class. Internet access is required to access course materials outside of the classroom.

Students will receive a UCLA Extension Certificate of Completion at the end of the course.
